

Rounding Any Number

Steps for rounding a number:

1. Underline the place value it's asking you to round to.
2. Draw an arrow one place value to the right of that underlined number.
3. If the number with the arrow under it is 4 or less, keep the underlined number the same. If the number with the arrow is 5 or more, the underlined number gets rounded up.
4. Everything to the left of the underlined number gets copied as is. Everything to the right of the underlined number turns to a zero.
